

Magdalini Tsolaki



Magdalini Tsolaki is an Emeritus Professor of Neurology at the School of Medicine at Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. She obtained her Medical degree from the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH) in 1978 and specialized in Neurology-Psychiatry in 1983, after first fulfilling her rural service obligation. She completed her doctoral dissertation at the 1st Neurological Clinic and received her PhD from the Medical School of AUTH. in 1983. She has been working at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki since 1982 and at the 3rd Neurological Clinic of the same university from 1988 until 2017. From 2017 to 2020, she worked as the Director of the 1st Neurological Clinic. She is the primary author or co-author of 63 books. She has participated with 350 abstracts in Greek conferences, 272 abstracts in international or European conferences, and is the first author or co-author of 175 papers in Greek journals and 567 in international journals—464 of which are listed in PubMed, with an Impact Factor of 2653.303, an h-index of 90, and over 30,000 citations. She has reviewed articles for conferences and journals (321). She has organized 24 national conferences or seminars on Alzheimer's disease and six international ones. She was one of the three advisory members for 26 doctoral dissertations. She founded the Greek Association of Alzheimer's Disease in 1995 and the Greek Federation of Alzheimer's Disease in 2007. She is also the president of this federation, having given 630 lectures and participated in television and radio programs. She has participated in 66 research projects and 42 clinical trials. She has received a total of 75 awards.
