

## Sidiropoulos Christos

Christos Sidiropoulos, MD, PhD, FAAN, is a movement disorders specialist in Thessaloniki Greece, a Consultant Neurologist at St Luke's Hospital in Thessaloniki and a Professor of Neurology at Michigan State University, East Lansing, Michigan. He graduated from Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, trained in psychiatry in Erlangen University, Germany and completed his neurology residency at Henry Ford Hospital, Detroit, USA. Subsequently he pursued a one-year fellowship in Movement Disorders and Deep Brain Stimulation at the University of Toronto. He worked as a Consultant Neurologist in the USA for 8 years prior to returning to his home city in 2022. He has published extensively in the field of movement disorders and has participated in numerous clinical trials. Dr Sidiropoulos is a member of several international scientific associations and peer reviewer in a plethora of scientific journals. His particular clinical and research interests cover the whole spectrum of Movement Disorders, including Deep Brain Stimulation, Neurogenetics and Botulinum Toxin applications.
