Dr. Anthoula C. Tsolaki, received her diploma in Medicine in 2008 by the medical school of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. Her postgraduate studies continued with her Ph.D, in 2020, about risk factor genes for Alzheimer's Disease and non-pharmaceutical interventions, and a Master in Neuroimmunology, in 2024. She received a scholarship from European Academy of Neurology and performed a Fellowship in Vascular Neurology in 2022, in Christian-Doppler Clinic, Salzburg, Austria. She received her specialty in Neurology in 2020, in "Agios Pavlos" General Hospital of Thessaloniki. She has been trained in the use of Botulinum Toxin for medical purposes in Greece and abroad. Since then, she has worked in Greek Association of Alzheimer's Disease and related disorders (2009-2013, 2024-on going). She worked as Researcher in Information Technologies Institute, Centre for Research and Technology, on a research project with dense array (256 channels) EEG recordings(2013-2014). She worked as Academic Scholar at AHEPA University Hospital, in the 1st Neurology Department 2020-2023. Currently, she works as a Neurology Consultant in Euromedica General Clinic of Thessaloniki and in private practice. She teaches in the Masterclass course of "Neurosciences and Neurodegenerative Diseases". She collaborates as a physician with the Greek Association of Alzheimer's Disease and related disorders. From 2008 till now she has participated in 4 pharmaceutical double-blind research, and in a non-pharmaceutical European research project EDAR, Elidek Postdoctoral Research, and two Horizon European Projects (Biomic, 2D-BioPAD) about Alzheimer's Disease. Publications in international journals in the fields of Neurology, Neurophysiology, Neuro-epidemiology, Neurobiology, Geriatrics and Alzheimer's Disease (>50 in international peer reviewed Journals).
